

What is the course about and what are the entry requirements?

This course forms part of the Level 3 academic pathway.

What subjects will I study?

Chemistry is the study of materials, their structure and interactions with each other. You will study a range of topics covering organic, inorganic and physical chemistry that develops your understanding from Chemistry or Science at level 2.

How will I be assessed?

Three AS exams at the end of the first year.

- Multiple choice paper (60 mins) worth 15.5%
- AS Structured questions exam paper (75 mins) worth 23%
- Advanced practical skills (practical examination) (120 mins) worth 11.5%

Two further exams at the end of the second year to complete the full A-level.

- A Level Structured questions exam paper (120 mins) worth 38.5%
- Planning, Analysis and Evaluation written exam paper (75 mins) worth 11.5%

What are my progression and career options?

Successful completion with satisfactory attendance allows progression to UCM's Higher Education (HE) courses our HE prospectus has the full range of Degrees offered here on the Isle of Man. Alternatively, you could seek employment and explore UCM's part-time prospectus for a relevant qualification in your new career.
