What subjects will I study?

- Number
- Algebra and graphs
- Geometry

- Probability
- Statistics

How will I be assessed?

All assessment is by final examinations.

- Core: Paper 1 (1 hour, 35%) & Paper 3 (2 hours, 65%) for Grades C to G

A scientific calculator is permitted in all of the written examinations.

What are my progression and career options?

Successful completion with satisfactory attendance allows progression to Level 3 study, an apprenticeship or vocational courses. Alternatively, you could seek employment and explore UCM's part-time prospectus for a relevant qualification in your new career.
