

What is the course about and what are the entry requirements?

This course forms part of the Level 3 academic pathway.

What subjects will I study?

The study of Cambridge International A Level Accounting allows learners to take the first step towards a career in accountancy and business. With a good understanding of the subject, students can progress to a degree in a related field, or go on to study for the professional qualifications of one of the major accounting bodies.

The key topic areas are:

An understanding of how to plan, budget and manage financial resources.

An ability to critically apply, analyse and evaluate accounting policies and practices.

An understanding how to use accounting information to make viable business decisions

How will I be assessed?

Paper 1 – Multiple choice 1 hour – 30 multiple choice questions based on the AS Level syllabus content.

Paper 2 – Structured questions 1 hour 30 minutes – four structured questions on the AS Level syllabus content

Paper 3 – Structured questions 3 hours – Paper 3 tests the additional content for the A Level, but also requires a knowledge and understanding of the AS Level content.

What are my progression and career options?

Successful completion with satisfactory attendance allows progression to UCM's Higher Education (HE) courses. Our HE prospectus has the full range of Degrees offered here on the Isle of Man. Alternatively, you could seek employment and explore UCM's part-time prospectus for a relevant qualification in your new career.
