

What is the course about and what are the entry requirements?

This course forms part of the Level 2 academic pathway.

The WJEC Level 1 / 2 Award in Event Operations is made up of three mandatory units. Learners must complete all three units.

The WJEC Level 2 Award in Event Operations has been designed to support learners who want to learn about this vocational sector and the potential it can offer them for their careers or further study. It is most likely to be studied alongside other GCSEs and vocational qualifications. It is a GCSE equivalent.

What subjects will I study?

The three units comprise:

Unit 1 – The Event Industry. This unit provides an introduction to the events industry. Learners will study the different types of events and the types of organisations that can help to plan and run them.

Unit 2 – Event Operations. This unit provides an opportunity for the learner to take part in running an event, working as part of a team, providing customer service and demonstrating effective communication.

Unit 3 – Event Planning. In this unit the learner will draw on their knowledge and understanding of the events industry and factors affecting the success of events to propose a plan for an event to meet specific needs.

How will I be assessed?

Unit 1 is assessed through a 90 minute external assessment which contributes 40% of the final grade. Units 2 and 3 are assessed through a controlled assessment that is an internal task and contributes 60% of the final grade.
