
ABC Awards Level 1 Diploma in Motor Vehicle Studies (Full-Time)

What is the course about?

The aim of this valuable qualification is to offer learners the opportunity to develop their basic skills and knowledge to allow progression into a career in the motor vehicle industry or to a higher-level course. It is designed to provide you with a practical experience and enhance employment opportunities.

The programme comprises of modules involving practical work and essential knowledge related to motor vehicles that may include Contact with Customers, Routine Servicing of Motor Vehicles, Identifying Faulty Components, Replacing and Removing Components/Units and Rectifying Faults. It also includes Maintaining Health and Safety, Good Housekeeping and Maintaining Working Relationships.

What are the entry requirements?

There are no formal entry qualifications although you will be required to take a College assessment. Enthusiasm will need to be demonstrated at interview.

How will I be assessed?

Assessment Method for this award is by creating a portfolio of evidence recording practical based tasks and supported by classroom study, which will be matched to gaining units along the programme to achieve the various learning aims.

How long will the Course last?

One Year
