
Level 3, Apprenticeship in Information Technology

Part-time, two years.

What is the course about?

This level 3 national qualification (equivalent to 'A' Levels) is designed to provide specialist IT work-related experience and skills that will complement your employment. Because this is an apprenticeship course, you will be working in an IT company and will attend UCM one day a week. Study is on a Wednesday between 9.00 and 18.00.

What are the entry requirements?

Employment and at least 4 GCSEs grade A to C or a BTEC level 2 Extended Certificate in ICT at Merit level.

What Subjects will I study?

The mandatory units are:

- Communication & Employability
- Computer Systems
- Information Systems

Optional units will be taken from:

- Impact on the use of IT on Business Systems
- Client side customisation of Web Sites
- Maintaining Computer Systems
- Website Production
- HCI
- Website Production

Units are subject to change over the duration of the course.
You may have the opportunity to improve your GCSE English and Maths grades.

How will I be assessed?

Assessment is by written coursework and practical activities.

What are my progression and career options?

Continued employment and part-time study at UCM with the HNC in Computing or the HNC in Administration and IT.
