What is the course about?

This course ensures that you gain knowledge of basic hairdressing prior to entering this exciting world. The course is designed to develop all the skills you will require to enable you to become an assistant. You will experience all aspects of practical hairdressing and complete units required by City & Guilds, while being involved in the buzz of the training salon, where you will be supporting the Level 2 students with their clients.

The course is practically based with the necessary theory of underpinning knowledge to ensure complete understanding of all aspects of hairdressing. You will have an introduction to chemistry, physics, anatomy and biology.

What are the entry Requirements?

There are no formal academic entry requirements, although you should have a degree of artistic skill and flair, a willingness to learn and a positive attitude.

What Subjects will I study?

Prepare for hair services and maintain work area
Shampoo and condition hair
Contribute to the development of effective working relationships
Blow dry hair
Assist with hair colouring and lightening services
Assist with salon reception duties

How will I be assessed?

The practical assessments will be achieved within the Synnova training salon throughout the course. The underpinning knowledge is assessed by oral questions and externally set Evolve multiple choice on-line papers.
