## What is the course about?

This evening class will provide you with the qualification and necessary skills to design a variety of photographic make-up looks, including period make-up, bridal make-up and fantasy make-up for both colour and black and white photographs.

## What are the entry requirements?

There are no formal entry requirements. However, you will need good communication skills and dexterity.

You will be required to work on each other during class to enable you to develop the necessary practical skills.

## Course fees

Course fees are inclusive of tuition, assessment and registration fees. Additional fees will be required for salon uniform, relevant kit, equipment and text book.

## How long is the course?

15 weeks – 3 hours per week

## What subjects will I study?

The qualification consists of one unit:

The Art of Photographic Make-up

This unit is about developing creative design skills for photographic make-up, the ability to plan and create different make-up looks is also required. You will evaluate your results against your agreed design brief. You will need to communicate effectively and be aware of hygiene, health and safety in this unit.

## How will I be assessed?

Practical assessments are carried out throughout the year in the purpose build training salons using high quality, professional products, while the underpinning knowledge is checked through assignments and online exams. Evidence is compiled into an e-portfolio, which can be viewed and amended from any smartphone, tablet or computer with internet access.

## What are my progression and career options?

Employment in salons worldwide, on cruise ships, or as a mobile or freelance make-up artist.
