
V.T.C.T. Level 2 NVQ Award in Make-Up

What is the course about?

This evening class will provide you with the qualification and necessary skills to carry out a variety of make-up looks for different occasions.

What are the entry requirements?

There are no formal entry requirements, however, you will need good communication skills and dexterity.

You will be required to work on each other during class to enable you to develop the necessary practical skills.

Course fees

Course fees are inclusive of tuition, assessment and registration fees. Additional fees will be required for salon uniform, relevant kit, equipment and text book.

How long is the course?

15 weeks - 3 hours per week

What subjects will I study?

The qualification consists of one unit;

Provide make-up services

This unit is about providing make-up services for a variety of occasions, including day, evening and special occasions. You will need to show you can work with a variety of skin types and conditions. The qualification covers the application of a wide range of make-up products to different skin tones and age groups.

How will I be assessed?

Practical assessments are carried out throughout the year in the purpose built training salons using high quality, professional products, while the underpinning knowledge is checked through assignments and online exams. Evidence is compiled into an e-portfolio, which can be viewed and amended from any smartphone, tablet or computer with internet access.

What are my progression and career options?

Progression on to the Level 2 Award in Art of Photographic Make-up. Employment in salons worldwide, on cruise ships, or as a mobile or freelance make-up artist.
