
VTCT Level 3 NVQ Award in Indian Head Massage

In addition, you will need to attend 3, x2hr assessment sessions to complete the practical observations and to take the on-line exam. These dates and times will be agreed with individuals at mutually convenient times commencing in October after completion of the case studies.

What is the course about?

This is an intensive daytime course where you will infill into the full time class. It will provide you with relevant skills and knowledge to obtain the VTCT Level 3 NVQ Award in Indian Head Massage within the college training salon.

You will develop a sound knowledge of health and safety and client care and communication and the practical skills to provide the relaxing and stress relieving treatment of Indian Head Massage to a high level of occupational ability to enable you to provide your own services for clients.

What are the entry requirements?

There are no formal entry requirements, however, you should be working within the beauty, hairdressing or holistic therapies industry with access to the internet to upload evidence to your e-portfolio.

What subjects will I study?

The qualification consists of one unit:

Provide Indian Head Massage – this unit is about the skills involved in providing Indian Head Massage treatments and the ability to adapt massage techniques to suit individual client needs with and without the use of oils, while incorporating health, safety, hygiene and client care.

How will I be assessed?

Your assessor will observe a minimum of 3 practical Indian Head Massage treatments within the college training salon. Case studies will be completed in your own time with a minimum of 9 treatments, which must include 3 clients each receiving 3 Indian Head Massages respectively. The underpinning knowledge is assessed through observation and supplemented with online multiple-choice exams, oral questions and written work to produce evidence for your e-portfolio.
