What is the course about?

This course is intended for people who would like an up-to-date, widely recognised qualification in English. GCSE English is an entry requirement for a wide variety of jobs and further study and, as such, is a challenging but rewarding subject.

What are the entry requirements?

Students should be able to demonstrate that they have the commitment and motivation to complete the course and be competent with standard English.

What subjects will I study?

The course consists of lectures with an equivalent time spent on personal study and homework. The course enables learners to:

- develop the ability to communicate clearly, accurately and effectively when speaking and writing
- use a wide range of vocabulary, and the correct grammar, spelling and punctuation
- develop a personal style and an awareness of the audience being addressed.

Learners are also encouraged to read widely, both for their own enjoyment and to further their awareness of the ways in which English can be used. Cambridge IGCSE English also develops more general analysis and communication skills such as inference, and the ability to order facts and present opinions effectively.

How will I be assessed?

- Exam: Reading Passages (50%)
- Exam: Directed Writing and Composition (50%)
