What is the course about?

This course is intended for people who would like an up-to-date, widely recognised qualification in mathematics. GCSE Maths is an entry requirement for a wide variety of jobs and further study and, as such, is a challenging but rewarding subject.

What are the entry requirements?

Students should be able to demonstrate that they have the commitment to succeed at this level, and already be competent with basic numerical skills.

What subjects will I study?

The course consists of lectures (teaching and problem-solving), with a similar amount of time spent on personal study and homework.

- Number
- Algebra and graphs
- Geometry
- Mensuration
- Co-ordinate geometry
- Trigonometry
- Transformations
- Probability
- Statistics

Students should also supply the following:

- Scientific calculator with a fraction button; ruler; protractor; pair of compasses; pen; pencil; A4 paper

How will I be assessed?

Assessment is by final examination for Grades C to G

Core: Paper 1 (1 hour, 35%) & Paper 3 (2 hours, 65%)

A scientific calculator is permitted in both examinations.
