

What is the course about and what are the entry requirements?

This course forms part of the Level 3 academic pathway.

What subjects will I study?

Marine Science is the study of the oceans and seas and interactions between the organisms that live there, their environment and the impact humans have on this. You will study a range of topics covering biology, geography/geology, chemistry and physics.

How will I be assessed?

Two AS exams at the end of the first year.

- Structured questions on AS topics (90 mins) worth 30%
- Data-handling questions and free-response (75 mins) worth 20%

Two further exams at the end of the second year to complete the full A-level.

- Structured questions on A level topics (90 mins) worth 30%
- Data-handling questions and free-response (75 mins) worth 20%

What are my progression and career options?

Successful completion with satisfactory attendance allows progression to UCM's Higher Education (HE) courses our HE prospectus has the full range of Degrees offered here on the Isle of Man. Alternatively, you could seek employment and explore UCM's part-time prospectus for a relevant qualification in your new career.
