

What is the course about?

This course forms part of the Level 3 academic pathway.

What subjects will I study?

In Year 1

A selection of poetry from 'Songs of Ourselves 2', and a selection of short stories from 'Stories of Ourselves', 'Twelfth Night' (Shakespeare) and 'Philadelphia Here I Come' (Brian Friel)

In Year 2

'The Winter's Tale' (Shakespeare) and 'Wuthering Heights' (Emily Bronte)
'The Glass Menagerie' (Tennessee Williams) and 'Four Quartets' (T.S. Eliot)

How will I be assessed?

Paper 3 – Poetry and Prose (50% of the AS and 25% of the A Level)

Paper 4 – Drama (50% of the AS and 25% of the A Level)

Paper 5 – Shakespeare and other pre-20th century texts (25% of the A Level)

Paper 6 – 1900 to the present (25% of the A Level)

What are my progression and career options?
