
VTCT Level 2 NVQ Award in Providing Manicure Services

What is the course about?

This evening class will provide you with the qualification and necessary skills to carry out a full manicure treatment on clients.

What are the entry requirements?

There are no formal entry requirements, however you will need good communication skills and dexterity.

You will be required to work on each other during class to enable you to develop the necessary practical skills.

What subjects will I study?

The qualification consists of one unit;

Provide Manicure Treatments

This unit is about providing manicure services to clients. You will learn about consulting with the client, recognising any contra-indications, preparing for the service and producing a treatment plan. You will also learn about filing and buffing the nails, using skin and cuticle treatments, massaging the hand and lower arm and using a suitable nail finish. You will need to carry out effective health, safety and hygienic working practices.

Course fees

Course fees are inclusive of tuition, assessment and registration fees. Additional fees will be required for salon uniform, relevant kit, equipment and text book.

How long is the course?

15 weeks – 3 hours per week.

How will I be assessed?

Practical assessments are carried out throughout the year in the purpose built training salons using high quality, professional products, while the underpinning knowledge is checked through assignments and online exams. Evidence is compiled into an e-portfolio, which can be viewed and amended from any smartphone, tablet or computer with internet access.

What are my progression and career options?

Progress on to the Level 2 Award in Nail Technology.

Employment in salons worldwide, on cruise ships, or as a mobile or freelance nail technician.
