

## What is the course about?

The Level 2 Award in Drawing, forms part of the 'Creative Framework' suite of qualifications and have been designed and written by a team of leading practitioners from within the University of the Arts London. It will provide students with an exciting and challenging experience, which will introduce them to the rigours and rewards of exploring and working within the most fundamental of creative activities.

The qualifications, whilst allowing learners to build on prior experience, will require them to approach new intellectual and material challenges, designed to deliver an independent critical understanding and extended skills base.

## What will I study?

Students must complete the mandatory unit: Unit 2 Drawing and Measurement and one from nine optional units: Unit 1, Unit 3, Unit 4, Unit 5, Unit 6, Unit 7, Unit 8, Unit 9, Unit 10.

## Qualification aims

To enable the candidate to develop:

- An understanding of the value of drawing as a tool for creative activity
  - A range of drawing skills appropriate to the support of creative activity
  - A critical and analytical approach to drawing activity
  - An awareness of the different contexts, approaches and disciplines of drawing within creative activity
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- The Level 2 Award in Drawing is accredited to the national Qualifications and Credit Framework (QCF).
