

What is the course about?

BTEC Level 1 in Vocational Studies is a one-year programme of study offering you the opportunity to investigate different vocational areas. The vocational areas that you can study may include Business, Sport, Engineering, Construction, Health and Social Care, Digital Media, Art & Design, Hospitality & Tourism and Information Technology for example. Through studying a variety of vocational options it is hoped that you will widen your knowledge enabling you to make informed career choices.

With the vocational units you will have the chance to improve your functional skills in Maths and English.

What are the entry requirements?

No formal entry requirements except English and Maths are required to be at least Entry 3. Applications will be required to attend an interview.

What subjects will I study?

You will study mandatory units in Self-Assessment and Career Progression, together with a range of units that offer an experience of different vocational areas. Units are designed to be practical and will allow learners to develop employability skills, which will improve their career prospects. Functional Skills in English and Maths will form an integral part of this programme.

How will I be assessed?

Internally assessed portfolio of evidence and functional skills exams.

What are my progression and career options?

If you are successful in meeting all the learning objectives, you may apply for a Level 2 course and enhance your skills and career opportunities.
