How much is the programme?

This apprenticeship programme is funded by the Department for Education, Sport and Culture (DESC), which means that there is **no course fee**.

How long is the apprenticeship programme?

This is a two-year programme, during which you will gain experience in the industry and study part-time at UCM.

When can you start?

We offer September and January start dates to allow greater flexibility to you and your employer.

What are the entry requirements?

You must be employed on a minimum two-year contract in a Finance/Accounting related role and registered under a DESC apprenticeship agreement.
