What is the course about?

Individual encouragement given to develop your perceptive skills and practical techniques in oils and/or watercolour.

Colour mixing, simple perspective, composition, line, tone, texture and pattern.

Instruction on how to utilize the above elements to best express your individual response to subject matter. Class exercises will demonstrate how this can be achieved.
Focus and structured plan of action for further development.

Previous experience:

The course caters for complete beginners and those with plenty of experience. All that is needed is the desire to paint.

Equipment you need to bring:

Students are required to provide their own art materials and equipment.

A3 sketch book of watercolour paper (or alternative paper to suit your choice of medium).

At least 3 pencils in the B range eg. B, 2B, 4B

Eraser (rubber)

At least 3 good watercolour brushes, say sizes 2, 6, 10 (or alternatives for other media)

Jam jar for water

Palette eg old plate or plastic tray

The following watercolours are suggested in tubes or buy a box of assorted pans.

Alizarin crimson, cadmium red, lemon yellow, cadmium yellow, ultramarine blue, cerulean blue, sap green, viridian green, Paynes Grey and a tube of white gouache

Any other media you like to work inbring it along.

General Information:

The times advertised for courses, especially 1-day and short courses, will normally include break(s) and a lunch period, as appropriate, and by agreement with the tutor at the sessions.

Students attending one-day workshops might like to note that there are hot/cold drinks and snack vending machines (crisps, sweets, chocolate, biscuits etc) in the College Refectory, which will be open during the day, but there are no sandwiches etc available, so students might like to bring a packed lunch with them, which can be consumed in the Refectory.
