**Bullshit**: "Human-generated content that has no regard for the truth which a human then applies for communication and decision-making tasks"

**Botshit**: "Chatbot generated content that is not grounded in truth (i.e., hallucinations) and is then uncritically used by a human for communication and decision-making tasks"




